

Privacy Policy of the transatlantyk.org site

Out of concern for the safety and privacy of the Users of the transatlantyk.org Site we introduce our Privacy Policy, which describes in detail what personal information of the Users is or may be gathered when using the transatlantyk.org Site and in what way it is processed. This Privacy Policy has been adopted out of concern for the safety of personal information and in particular in order to prevent the access to it by unauthorized individuals.

It should be pointed out that personal information, as defined in the provisions of the personal data protection act as of 29th August 1997 (Journal of Laws 2002, No 101, pos. 926 with consecutive changes), includes all information referring to an identified or identifiable natural person. An identifiable individual is a person, whose identity may be defined directly or indirectly, in particular by referring to an identification number or one or several specific factors defining this person's physical, physiological, intellectual, economic, cultural or social features.

The administrator of the abovementioned information is the Site Operator, that is the Transatlantyk Foundation with its registered office in Poznań, 4/2 Langiewicza Street, 61-502 Poznań, entered into the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court of Poznań – Districts of Nowe Miasto and Wilda in Poznań, 8th Economic Department of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000370451, holding the Taxpayer Identification Number NIP 783-16-63-735 and the National Business Registry Number REGON 301597976.

The Operator processes personal information of the Users in accordance with the law, including, in particular, the personal data protection act as of 29th August 1997 (Journal of Laws 2002, No 101, pos. 926 with consecutive changes) and the act on rendering electronic services as of 18th July 2002 (Journal of Law 2001, No 144, pos. 1204 with consecutive changes). The rules established in this Privacy Policy enable the execution of rights resulting from the abovementioned legal instruments, including, in particular, the right of access to own personal information at any time, the right to correct it, the right to request updating and removal of information and the right to raise an objection. Execution of the abovementioned rights is carried out by sending an appropriate request to the Operator of the Site by e-mail at admin@transatlantyk.org, or by mail to the address of the Foundation.

With regards to using the Site, the Operator may gather data about electronic addresses (e-mail) of the Users, who take advantage of the newsletter function. The User provides his or her e-mail address voluntarily when subscribing for the newsletter. The Operator processes the abovementioned personal information only in the scope necessary to establish, define the content, change or terminate the Agreement or for the proper rendering of electronic services.

The IP numbers of devices connecting with the www.transatlantyk.org website are also gathered. The data gathered as a result of that procedure is used solely for analysis and verification of Site functioning. Thanks to it, for example, statistics of visits are created, which makes it possible to prepare reliable estimates on the interest in the Festival. Information on the IP numbers is also used for technical purposes. Under no circumstances do we combine personal information with the IP numbers of the devices connecting with the Site.

Some areas of the site may use cookies – text files saved on the User devices, which identify the User in a way necessary for some functions of the Site. Cookies are in no way processed.

Moreover, the Operator may process other personal information, in particular data necessary in order to safeguard the correct recruitment procedure of the Festival volunteers, participants in the Festival competition, as well as accrediting journalists (indicated in forms, which can be found on the website). It should be pointed out that the abovementioned information is not processed by means of this Site, but it is gathered by the Foundation outside of it, in accordance with the competition rules and the rules of volunteer recruitment and accrediting journalists.

All data processed by the Operator of the Site is protected in accordance with the provisions of the personal data protection act as of 29th August 1997 (Journal of Laws 2002, No 101, pos. 926 with consecutive changes). The data is not used for other purposes than granting the Users the correct access to the services offered by the Site. Personal information processing to purposes other than described above is possible only if a separate consent is granted.

The gathered data is not shared by the Site Operator with third parties without prior consent of the Users of the Site. The only situation when the Site Operator may disclose the gathered information in a way which is not dependent on the Operator is an explicit order resulting from the applicable law.

The Operator reserves the right to update and change this Privacy Policy by publishing its new version on this website. The changes to this Privacy Policy shall be announced with at least 14 days notice before coming into force. Any and all changes to this Privacy Policy can take place only with the aim of increasing safety.
